The evening detailed the pans for the forthcoming Hub and three local companies, Perry Riding for The Disabled (RDA), Red Recruitment Solutions and AJ Case Management, signed the Armed Forces Covenant with Col Richard Green, Deputy Commander, HQ 11 Signal and West Midlands Brigade signing on behalf of the Armed Forces. The Hub will be a point of Contact for the Armed Forces Community in Shropshire and will be run by Hub Coordinator Sarah Kerr.
