

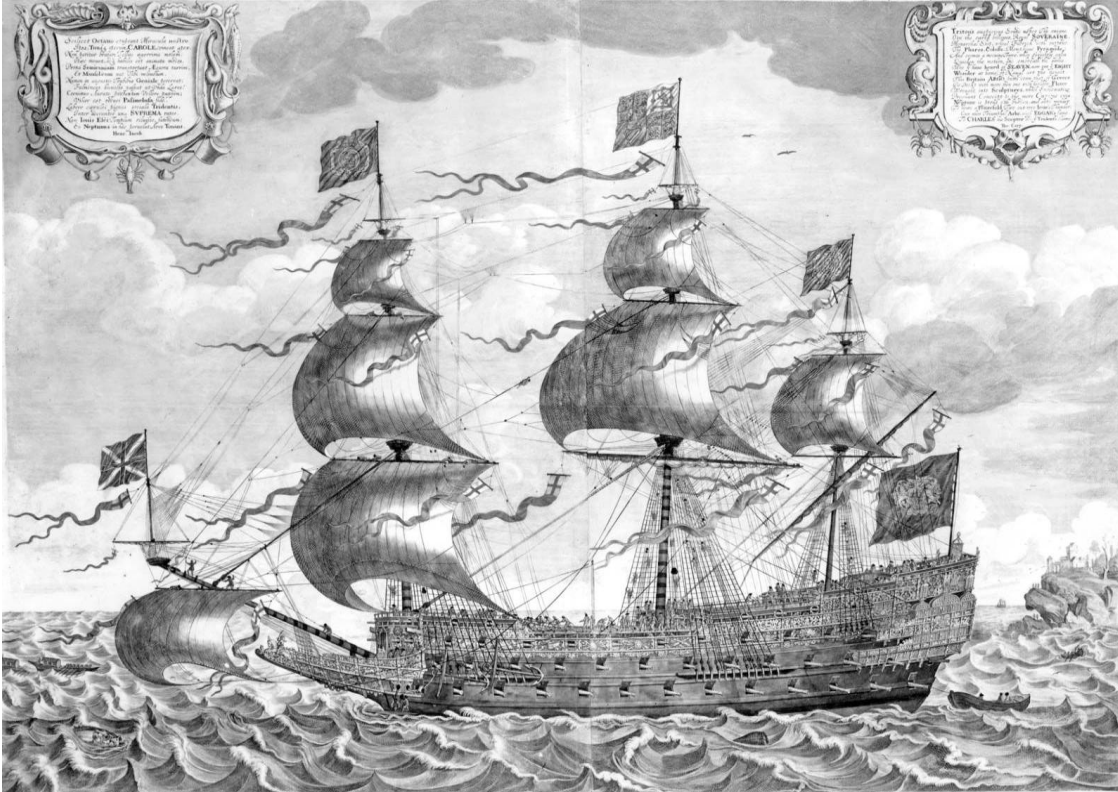

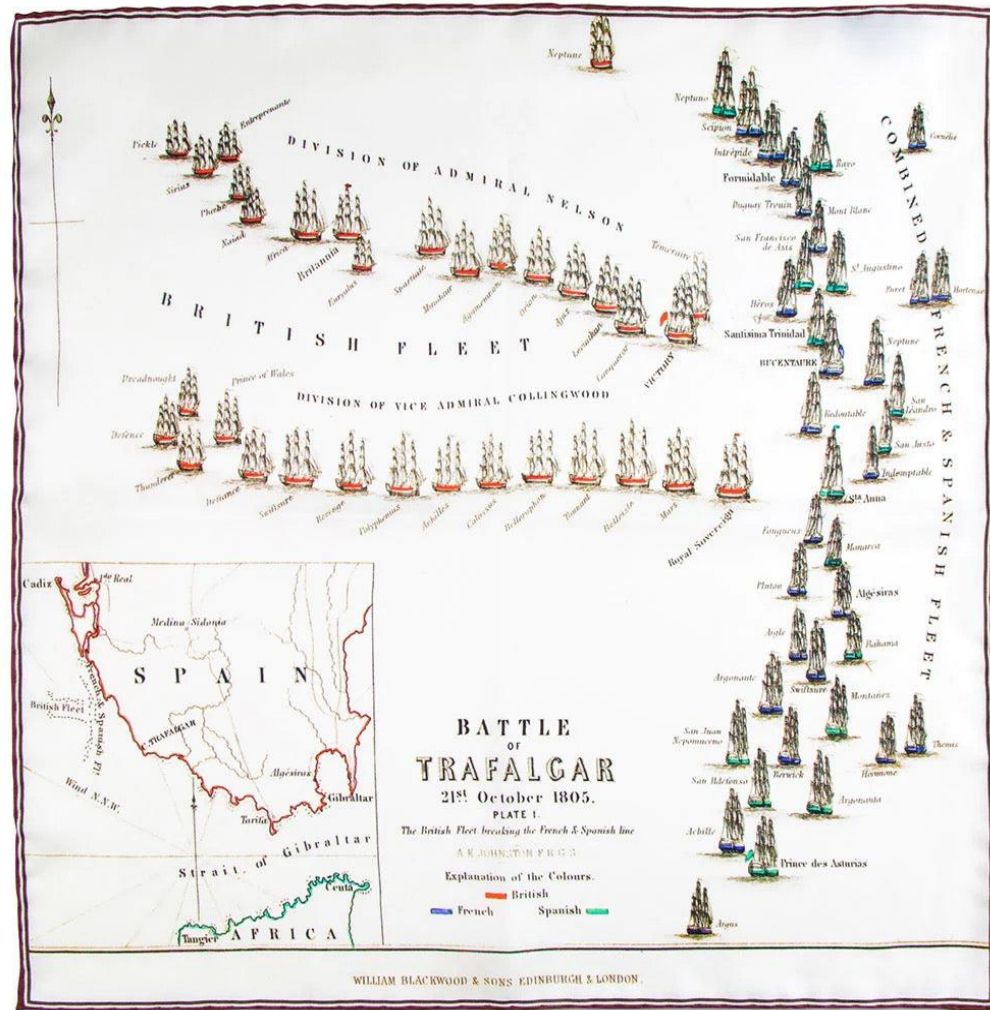

What is VALOUR?

VALOUR is a new UK-wide programme designed to make it easier for veterans and the Armed Forces Community across the UK to access the care and support they deserve in a timely and effective manner.



MOD Veterans Services

MOD Veterans Services delivers welfare support to veterans and service leavers, working with VALOUR to coordinate referrals and connect individuals to appropriate statutory and third-sector support.



VALOUR Field Officers

VALOUR Field Officers (VFOs) will encourage the development or support the evolution of existing regional networks with councils, public services and voluntary organisations. They will share insights from their region with VALOUR HQ to help shape better policies and services, and disseminate best practice locally.



VALOUR Centres

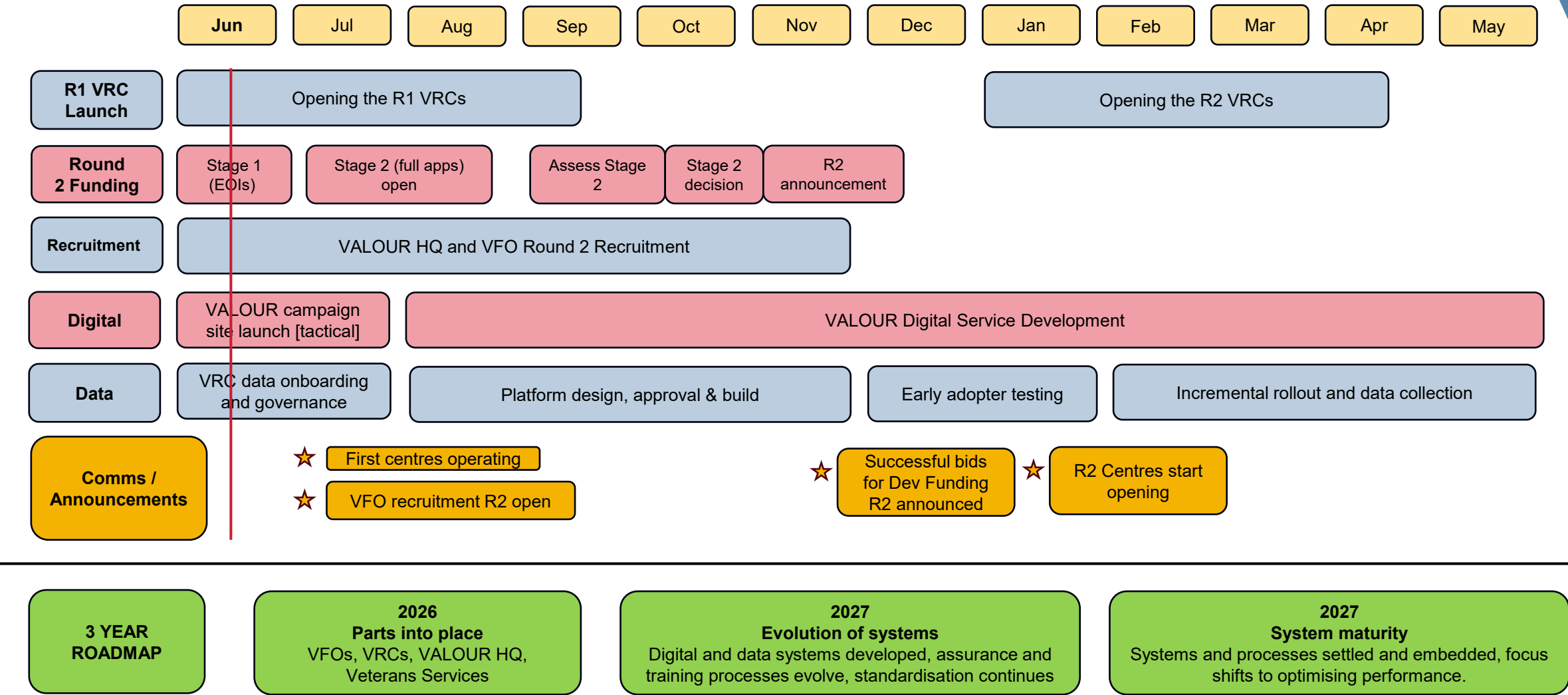
These centres will facilitate access to multiple services for veterans and the AFC. They will be required to meet high standards and provide timely data to the UK government about the needs and experiences of veterans and the AFC to inform future service improvements.



VALOUR Headquarters

VALOUR HQ will be based in the Office for Veterans' Affairs provide training and quality assurance across the VALOUR network, gathering data and working with policy teams to make sure services meet local needs. A new digital service will help veterans find the right support and collate data.
